

Data Privacy Consent Statement

- 1) By accepting this data privacy consent statement published by Hungarian Gas Trade Ltd. (seat: 1138 Budapest, Váci út 144-150.; tax number: 12543300-2-44; trade registry number: 01-10-045044, e-mail: gaconference@mfgk.hu, operational licence number issued by the Hungarian Energy and Public Utility Regulatory Authority - 1054 Budapest, Bajcsy-Zsilinszky út 52. - with regard to natural gas trade activity: 238/2009; hereinafter referred to as MFGK) in relation to the 49th International Gas Conference and Exhibition (hereinafter referred to as "Event") indicated on the website accessible via www.gazkonferencia.info and www.gasconference.net (hereinafter referred to as „Portal”), and by marking it as accepted on the Portal, User grants – under the conditions herein – its voluntary consent to MFGK for the sake of organizing and conducting further conference to be held following the Event covering the same subject – particularly for the purposes of sending electronic advertisements, newsletters, information materials or other dedicated contents addressed to the User – to manage natural personal identification data and address, along with the email address submitted on the Portal during application (hereinafter referred to as personal data), and to transfer and disclose them – for data processing – for the same purposes to third parties under supply or services contract with MFGK (hereinafter referred to as subcontractors), pursuant to Section 5, Subsection (1) a) of Act No. CXII of 2011 on the Right of Informational Self-Determination and on Freedom of Information (hereinafter referred to as Info Act), having regard to Section 13/A, Subsection (4) of Act No. CVIII of 2001 on Certain Aspects of Electronic Commerce Services and Services related to Information Society (hereinafter referred to as E-Commerce Act).
- 2) Personal data included in its data management shall neither be published or transferred abroad, nor disclosed by MFGK to third parties other than to said subcontractors, and subcontractors shall not be entitled in any way to keep or disclose to third parties any of the personal data received.
- 3) MFGK shall ensure data safety, and shall take any and all technical measures and establish procedural rules that are required for the implementation of data protection provisions, in line with the Info Act and the E-Commerce Act.
- 4) User shall be responsible for the accuracy, veracity and completeness of the data submitted by the User. MFGK shall not be held responsible for any damage arising from incorrectly submitted data even if it could have detected such data inaccuracy. In the event that the User acts on behalf of another person, User shall be responsible to ensure and certify that User has a data privacy consent statement issued by the relevant person under the conditions identical to those of this Data Privacy Statement and information.
- 5) Personal data management commences upon clicking on the Send button – provided the User marked the data privacy consent statement as accepted on the Portal – , and shall end when the deletion of personal data is requested, when the data management purpose ceases to exist or when the User prohibits the management of data.
- 6) User shall be entitled to the following rights and legal remedies in relation to data management:

- a) User may request information on personal data management from MFGK using its contact details (e-mail: info@mfgk.hu; postal address: 1398 Budapest Pf. 564., phone number: 354-7000); during which MFGK provides information on the data it manages, on the purpose, legal basis and duration of data management, or on data processing, or on the legal basis and recipient of data transfer. (Section 14-15 of the Info Act) MFGK shall provide such information in writing within 25 days, which may only be refused on grounds specified by law. In the event that the provision of information is refused, User may resort to judicial remedy to enforce its rights, or may request an investigation from the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (hereinafter referred to as NAIH). (Section 16 of the Info Act)
- b) User may request the correction, deletion or blocking of personal data at any time from MFGK using the contact details specified in item a). Personal data are deleted, corrected or blocked – unless the request is refused by MFGK – within 5 business days from receiving the request. Where MFGK does not carry out the request for correction, blocking or deletion, the factual and legal reasons for the refusal shall be communicated to the User within 30 days. In the event that the request is refused, User may resort to judicial remedy to assert its rights, or may request an investigation from NAIH. (Section 18, Subsection (2) of the Info Act).
- c) User may object to the management of their personal data in a statement submitted to MFGK using the contact details specified in item a) if the lawfulness of data management is contested; in which case MFGK shall inform the User with regard to the decision in writing. Insofar as Users disagrees with the decision, they may refer the matter to court (court of justice) in order to assert their rights, in which case the court proceeds urgently. (Sections 21-22 of the Info Act)
